Weekly Programs

FOCUS

FOCUS is our Sunday morning program. From 11:00am-12noon, students gather for fellowship, announcements, and small groups based on age and gender.

NIGHTlife

NIGHTlife is our once a month Sunday evening program for middle and high school students. Students will participate in a lesson followed by time to hang out and experience peer fellowship. We will provide pizza and drinks for the students. NIGHTlife is held the 2nd Sunday of every month.

FRONTLINE

FRONTLINE is our weekly High School Bible Study. We meet Monday nights from 6:30-8pm at Bill and Sarah's home:
11560 Aldburg Way, Germantown, MD 20876. The hour and a half time slot is a time to fellowship and dive into the Word.

BREAK-THRU

BREAK-THRU is our Wednesday night program from 6:30-8:00pm. We meet every Wednesday night during the school year. We have Open Gym the first Wednesday of every month from 6:00-6:30pm

- 6-6:30pm Open Gym for basketball (first Wednesday of each month)
- 6:30-8pm Announcements, games, and a message. The group is divided into middle and high school. Youth are encouraged to bring friends, hang out, listen to music, and play video games. We discuss real issues that the students face everyday and dive into God's Word to see how we should respond.

Dress Code

Everyone:

1. Please do not wear anything that advertises alcohol, tobacco and illegal drugs.
2. Please do not wear anything that promotes racism, sexism, or hatred toward any group or person.
3. Please do not wear anything that refers to sexual actions or situations.

Ladies:

1. Please do not wear anything that is low cut and shows cleavage.
2. Shorts and skirts should pass the fingertip test.
3. Please do not wear anything that is extremely tight. (Leggings and yoga pants are ONLY acceptable when worn with a shirt long enough to go to mid-thigh.)
4. Do not dress in a way that calls attention to your underwear or bra.
5. In the event that bathing suits are worn, please have a one-piece bathing suit, or a two-piece with a dark t-shirt to wear over it.

Guys:

1. A shirt should be worn at all times unless otherwise instructed.
2. If you are going to sag your pants, please make sure that your shirt is long enough to cover your boxers. (If I can see your boxers, I WILL make you pull your pants up.)
3. In the event that bathing suits are worn, NO SPEEDOS!!!

If someone shows up to an activity not adhering to this dress code, he/she will be asked to change before participating.

Please understand that we are not trying to cause problems but to teach our students to live up to the standards that God has for us. We don't want the way someone is dressed to distract from other students from what God has for him or her. Visitors will receive grace from the dress code until a relationship is established and the issue can be dealt with in confidential manner. If the visitor is a friend of a regular 412 student, then that student is responsible for letting them know the dress code before they attend.
