

# 412 Student Ministries Policies and Procedures

## **Personal Faith**

- I have accepted Jesus as my Lord and Savior and have a personal relationship with Him.
- I am taking steps toward growth and maturity in my relationship with Christ (Attending worship, personal Bible study, accountability)
- I am committed to a Godly lifestyle in all areas of my life (spiritually, physically, emotionally, sexually).
- If at anytime I am struggling with a serious sin issue I will pull myself out of the ministry and seek pastoral help.

## **Personal Conduct**

- I will not use foul or inappropriate language around the students or engage in inappropriate joking or pranks.
- I will never be with a student alone, especially a student of the opposite sex, without parental permission.
- I will not call, text, or email a student of the opposite sex without permission from the Youth Pastor.
- I will only message a student on Facebook if it's a wall post that everyone can see. I will not send a personal Facebook message to a student of the opposite sex without permission from the Youth Pastor.
- I will not participate in a dating relationship with a student at any time.
- I will not enter into a dating relationship with another youth leader without permission from the Youth Pastor.
- I will not consume alcohol in the presence of students or come to event after consuming alcohol.
- I will not consume illegal drugs at all.
- I will follow the 412 Student Ministry dress code at all 412 sponsored events and programs.
- I understand that my conduct outside the church walls should also line up with the word of God knowing that I am an example in and out of the church.

## **General**

- I understand I must have an up to date Child Protection Policy to work with the student ministry

- I understand that this is a year commitment.
- If I am unable to attend a youth activity (ie Sunday morning, Wednesday night or a monthly event) I will contact the Youth Pastor by phone.
- I understand that all activities I plan involving 412 students must receive advance approval from the Youth Pastor.
- I will be a team player and submit to the authority of the Youth Pastor.
- I will have a positive attitude at all times when I am around the students and understand that any personal grievances or frustrations should not be brought up in front of the students.
- If any problems arise with the Youth Pastor or another youth worker, the Matthew 18 model will be used.
- I will report any dangerous, unlawful or disturbing behavior to the Youth Pastor.
- I understand that the students always come first before my own personal needs.
